

## Interline Baggage Rules

You may be subject to additional regulations if you are travelling to/or from the United States or San Juan (Puerto Rico) and you are not only flying with Condor, e.g., if feeder or connecting flights are operated by other airlines. In this case, the following baggage rules apply for the whole itinerary.
