Grenada to be Condor's new destination in the Caribbean

Third additional destination in Winter 2014/15 / One weekly flight from Frankfurt

Frankfurt am Main, 11 March 2014 – Condor, the leisure airline, is adding a further destination to its route portfolio: from November 2014, there will be one non-stop flight to Grenada from Frankfurt on Saturdays. With turquoise waters, quiet bays with picture-book beaches, houses painted in pretty colours, spice plantations and volcanoes, Condor will help dreams of the Caribbean to come true in Grenada.

The capital of St. George's is considered one of the prettiest ports in the Antilles. Plus there are crater lakes, impressive waterfalls, old forts and warm springs to explore. Grenada is considered the "delicatessen" of the Caribbean. The spice island is the world's second biggest exporter of nutmeg. Just a pinch of this delectable spice is all it takes to enhance fabulous fish and meat dishes – and even drinks. Fine chocolate is also made here.

The Caribbean state with its three islands of Grenada, Carriacou and Petit Martinique is a "travel destination away from the well-trodden paths, and paradise for the discerning traveller," reports the Minister of Tourism, Civil Aviation and Culture, the Hon. Alexandra Otway-Noel. "We are delighted that starting this winter, there will be a connection from Frankfurt to Grenada, and that German-speaking visitors will be able to explore our islands."

Condor is currently upgrading its entire long-haul fleet with modern new cabins, a task that is scheduled for completion in summer 2014. The Grenada flights are planned to be carried out with a new Boeing 767-300 with the latest cabin interior: in-seat entertainment in all classes; modern new seats, and a new Business Class with reclining seats and 15" screens. Of course, Grenada is not only easy to reach from Hesse. Connecting flights to Frankfurt from many German and European airports can easily be booked at the same time. Condor also offers excellent rail connections for €33 per person and route.

On an annual basis, 7 million passengers fly with Condor to around 75 destinations in Europe, Asia, Africa and America. 13 Boeing 757-300s and 12 Boeing 767-300s. The aircraft are maintained by the airline's own technical operations. Condor is co-initiator of the four-litre-campaign of the federal association of German aviation (BDL): German aviation consumption of kerosine is less than 4 litres per passenger on 100 kilometres.
