

Condor expands its route network in North America

Over 30 new connecting flights with Alaska Airlines in Summer 2011

Kelsterbach, 24 February 2011 – In Summer 2011 there will be new destinations just waiting to be discovered in North America. From 24 June 2011, Condor will fly to Seattle, into the hub of the US west coast carrier Alaska Airlines with whom the charter carrier has been collaborating for over two years. Under the keywords EASY CONNECTIONS, this partnership means Condor can offer its passengers connecting flights to over 30 new destinations in the Pacific Northwest region, from Edmonton via Spokane to Portland, in California from Sacramento to San Diego and the holiday island of Hawaii.

"We coordinate our flight times to Seattle with Alaska Airlines departures so our passengers have only short transfer times to their connecting flights. Flying into Alaska Airlines was the next logical step following the successful expansion of our connections in Brazil with GOL and in the Caribbean with Copa", explains Achim Lameyer, Director of Single Seat Sales for Condor. "By expanding our route schedule in this way, we can offer our passengers over 150 destinations on the American continent."
