Kelsterbach, 24 June 2011 – At 15:20 hrs in Frankfurt today, the first Condor Boeing 767-300 took off for Calgary, the fourth biggest and fastest growing city in Canada. Calgary airport is a hub in the province of Alberta. As of today, Condor is operating non-stop flights from Frankfurt on Mondays and Fridays. The flights will be offered throughout the summer season.

“The non-stop flight to Calgary now gives our passengers even more flight options to Canada. This addition to our schedule is part of our network extension for summer 2011,” explains Achim Lameyer, Vice President Passenger Sales at Condor. Calgary is a modern city with a cultural offer that includes art galleries and annual festivals. The centre of country music in Canada, it is also called the “Nashville of the North”.
