

## ***Summer 2012: Condor to triple its Balkan flights and supplement its destinations in Greece***

***New connections to Rijeka, Dubrovnik, Tivat, Constanza, Mykonos, Preveza, Karpathos and Bodrum***

Kelsterbach, 4 October 2011 – In summer 2012, Condor will be taking off towards the Balkans three times as often as in summer 2011. Apart from current flights to Split in Croatia and Burgas in Bulgaria, Condor is to add another four destinations: departing from Frankfurt, Condor will fly once a week to Rijeka/Croatia (Saturdays), Dubrovnik/Croatia (Sundays), Tivat/Montenegro (Wednesdays), Bodrum (Mondays) and Constanza/Romania (Tuesdays). It will also be possible to reach Tivat and Constanza on the same days departing from Berlin while Condor will take off for Constanza from Düsseldorf every Thursday.

Rijeka, Dubrovnik and Tivat will supplement flights to Split/Croatia which were successfully introduced in summer 2011. Magnificently located on Kotor Bay, Tivat is attractive thanks to its new golf courses kept green all year by a mild Mediterranean climate. Dubrovnik enjoys international acclaim for its historic old quarter and many cultural events as well as representing a popular starting point for boat trips through the Adriatic and the same applies to Rijeka on Kvarner Bay between Istria and the islands of Krk and Cres. In the form of Constanza, Condor also supplements its Black Sea destinations: more than 2,500 years old, this city offers an interesting mix of archaeological sites, historical sights, beautiful beaches, unique natural habitats in the Danube Delta as well as exciting night life.

The Greek island of Mykonos in the Aegean Sea is equally famous for its night life along with its majestic scenery which Condor will also fly to every Wednesday from Frankfurt as of summer 2012. Karpathos on the Dodekanes with its wide variety of beaches will also be services from Frankfurt every Tuesday as well as Preveza on the Ionian Sea every Saturday and from where Condor passengers can easily travel on to the Ionian islands of Lefkos and Kefalonia as well as the Epirus region with its district capital of Ioannina or western Greece and its regional capital of Patras.
