

## New service for passengers: Condor now serving vegan menu Leisure airline extending menu options for passengers on board

Frankfurt/Main, 15th August 2013 – As of 1 September 2013, Condor passengers will be able to preorder a vegan menu to enjoy on board. <u>Condor</u> is responding to requests by numerous passengers, adding another option to its <u>on-board menu offer</u>. The type of meal served is determined by the departure time. Condor serves breakfast, or a cold or hot meal. The new vegan menu consists of an antipasti platter with couscous salad, a stuffed tomato with diced cucumber, Italian vegetable terrine with olives, fruit salad, sunflower bread, vegetable spread or margarine, mineral water and cashew nuts, he adds.

Condor's menu consists of first-class meals that are prepared from carefully selected fresh ingredients for passengers of all ages. Passengers requiring a special menu for health or personal reasons can easily order special meals. A separate <u>children's menu</u> is available for our youngest passengers if desired. Special and Premium menus cost  $\in$  7.00 per person on short-,  $\in$  10.00 on medium- and  $\in$  15.00 on long haul flights. They can be ordered up to 48 hours before departure, online at <u>Condor.com</u>.
